

Halloween Parade Route & Celebration Guidelines

The entire parade will occur outdoors. Review the parade route below to consider the best location to view all the students' costumes. All parties will end at 10a in order to continue with academics.

Student Parade Route

- The students will begin their procession at 8:30a.
- All students will line up along the outside wall of their classroom.
- Classroom teachers will lead students in walking along the outside walls of the school (beginning with the 4th graders).
- When a teacher reaches a new class, the new class will begin to follow the class in front of them.
- Students will be lead around the entire perimeter of the building and will re-enter their classroom through their exterior door.

Parents/Visitors Expectations

- We are asking all parents/visitors to find a location outside the school building to view the parade.
- Cones will be set up on the playground to create a viewing area for parents/visitors. Parents/visitors should leave space between the building and the cones open for students and staff.
- **After the parade, parents/visitors must sign in at the tables in the hall just outside the office and wear a visitor sticker. Do not enter the school through classroom doors.** Because the parties will end at 10am, we will assume you have left our building by 10:20a. If you are remaining at school to volunteer for something other than the parties, please sign in the office as usual.

In order to ensure student safety and an orderly celebration, please read the guidelines below.

Students

May	May Not
Come to school with costume and make-up.	Get ready at school. Costumes must be complete prior to coming to school.
Bring extra clothing to change after party.	Keep costumes on after the Halloween party.
Wear make-up. (Makeup must be washed off immediately after the Halloween party.)	Wear masks or any partial or full head covering. Student's face must be visible.
Wear costume accessories (gloves, wands, hats, etc...).	Bring play guns, knives, swords, hooks, or other violent accessories.
Wear an appropriate costume.	Wear costumes that reflect violence, blood, guts, gore, etc...

Parents/Visitors

May	May Not
Wear basic, appropriate costume.	Have face covered by a mask or an abundant amount of make-up. We should be able to identify you. Absolutely no play guns, knives, or other violent accessories should be brought to school.
Watch the Halloween parade as it proceeds around the exterior of the school.	Wander around the school during the parade.
Attend Halloween party. But must: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • enter and leave through main entrance • sign in at tables outside office • wear a visitor sticker 	Enter or leave through classroom doors.
